THE ACADEMIC ROUTE

At university you might study: Nursing (with multiple specialisms such as Adult, Child, Mental Health, Midwifery), Dentistry, Medicine, and multiple Science courses

These subjects are usually essential: Biology, Chemistry, Mathematics, Physics, Further Maths, Psychology, Computer Science/IT, Geography

Some subjects in this pathway will be essential for university study. For example, students interested in an academic Medicine pathway must study Biology and Chemistry, students interested in an academic Nursing pathways must study Biology, and students interested in a particular Science pathway must study the relevant Science A Level. We recommend that students refer to UCAS or speak to a member of the careers team to confirm this.
